Go about 1 mile and turn left, go across cattle guard, go another 300 yards, turn left up the hill to the large day use area. (No need to pull through the horse camp on the right.)

Ride JCHA Report: Karen House described the award program to the membership then announced two awards this month, Junior Member Sophia Brydon reached her 100 hours and Victoria Hanhart reached her 100 hours award as well. JCHA Event Planning:
