& De-Spooking Clinic November 15, 16 & 17 4G's Ranch, 109 Staley Rd, Eagle Point, OR

Friday, Nov 15th at 6:00pm is the Defensive Trail Rider Demo. Bill will show you how to defend



yourself and your horse from someone who has bad intentions out on the trail as things can go wrong quickly plus what to do if you happen to hear a drone and more. Please pre-register with Karen Swanson as only 5 demo horses/riders are needed for the evening.

The De-Spooking Clinic is Saturday & Sunday, Nov 16 & 17. Bill will talk about how horses perceive things and how to work "with" your horse at different obstacles each day. You'll work in a group setting in the arena. Bill teaches in a relaxed casual manner that before you know it, your horse is handling "life challenges" totally calm.
