Refreshments & Door Prize- Thanks went to Debbie Walker and Jill Mialkovsky for refreshments and to Karen House, Penny Boggs, Debra Smith, Dianne Gorman & Audrey Gillespie for furnishing the door prizes.

Introduction of New Members and Guests- No new members or guests this month.

October Meeting Minutes– Karen House reported there were 2 corrections to the newsletter, the meeting date and Dianne Gorman's business the Pitt Stop. Motion was made, 2nd and approved to accept the October minutes as read and corrected.
